FINANCIAL AID DATA

For the Class of 2014, financial aid of approximately \$28,600,000 was offered to 1,194 students. The aid consisted of approximately \$21,700,000 in Bucknell scholarships, \$1,100,000 in other grants, \$5,000,000 in student loans and \$800,000 in work-study.

Of the enrolled members of the Class of 2014, 523 students are receiving approximately \$15,300,000 in financial aid. That aid is distributed as \$11,500,000 in Bucknell scholarships, \$900,000 in other grants, \$2,550,000 in student loans and \$350,000 in work-study.

The average total financial aid package for first-year students with financial need is approximately \$26,500, which includes grants, scholarships, loans and work-study.

The average need-based loan debt for our 2010 graduates was approximately \$19,000.

Sixty-one percent of undergraduates receive some form of financial aid.
