- Bucknell admits students to intended majors and frequently receives large numbers of applicants to certain programs. We review your application according to your first-choice major listed on the next page. In some cases, the major you indicate may affect your chance of admission.
- It is fine to be undecided about your major at this time. If you are undecided, please write “undecided” in the space provided. Be sure to indicate whether you want to enroll as undecided in the College of Arts and Sciences, the School of Management within the College of Arts and Sciences, or the College of Engineering. Transfer from the College of Arts and Sciences into the College of Engineering at a later time cannot be guaranteed. Transfer into the School of Management from another program is also not guaranteed.
- If you want to apply for admission to a five-year, dual-degree program in engineering, please select a major or “undecided engineering” in the College of Engineering and list both the type of five-year program and the engineering major or undecided engineering in the space provided on the next page.

#### Transfer applicants:

- Biomedical engineering and all School of Management majors (including bachelor of management for engineers) are closed to transfer students. Transfer students cannot be admitted to these programs and will not be eligible for them at a later time. Engineering, biology and economics have limited spaces available to transfer students. If you are interested in a major that is limited, Bucknell recommends that you list it as your first-choice major, because enrollment in these programs cannot be guaranteed at a later time.
- Transfer applicants must note a choice of major and cannot choose undecided. Bucknell does not admit transfer students who have completed more than the equivalent of 2-1/2 years or 80 semester hours of college study.
