Your contribution to the Bucknell Brigade will help us provide much needed resources for poor families of Nueva Vida, Nicaragua. This resettlement community of 15,000 lost their meager homes and livelihoods to Hurricane Mitch in 1998. In March 1999, the first Bucknell Brigade worked side-by-side with refugees to help build simple temporary shelters. Two delegations have traveled there every year since to continue humanitarian efforts. Thanks to these volunteers and supporters like you, the people of Nueva Vida now have a free health clinic. The Bucknell Brigade is committed to providing funds to sustain the clinic and to support other Jubilee House Community empowerment projects.

You can donate one of three ways:

1. Cash or checks made out to "Jubilee House Community, Inc.," our host agency in Nicaragua. JHC is a non-governmental organization that helps Nicaraguans coordinate their efforts with external groups such as the Bucknell Brigade. Donations to JHC help to maintain the health clinic and support projects such as the worker-owned Women's Sewing Cooperative and the Organic Agricultural Cooperative to build empowerment and employment opportunities.

2. Cash or checks made out to "Bucknell Brigade." These donations support our local fundraising and educational efforts and subsidize student travel to Nicaragua to provide hands-on help. Student volunteers see the world with new eyes and bring home invaluable lessons about globalization, community development, and civic responsibility.
