Possible Threat to the Community

"Your Right to Know"

September 23, 2010

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal *Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998*, the Department of Public Safety is giving notice of an act of violence that reportedly occurred on the campus of Bucknell University, Lewisburg, Pennsylvania.

The Bucknell University Department of Public Safety is actively investigating a Sexual Assault that was reported to have occurred during a party late Saturday night at the Phi Gamma Delta (FIJI) fraternity house at 78 University Avenue. The incident was reported to Bucknell University Public Safety today, September 23, 2010.

REPORTED OFFENSE: An Aggravated Indecent Assault, Title 18 § 3125, was reported to have occurred between 11:30pm and Midnight on September 18, 2010 at the FIJI fraternity house. This location is an off-campus university student housing facility located at 78 University Ave., Lewisburg, PA

SUSPECT: White male, tall (possibly over 6'), with "thick" or athletic stature; college aged, with short hair.
Possibly wearing a diamond earring in each ear.
Wearing all black, and a black baseball cap with a flat brim.

The victim reports attending a party at the FIJI fraternity house. Sometime around between 11:30pm and Midnight she was pulled through a crowd of people into a room within the house where she was sexually assaulted by the above described assailant.

Until the investigation has been concluded it can be assumed that conditions continue to exist that may pose a threat to members and guests of the community. Pursuant to the Clery Act, it is the duty of the institution to warn of possible "dangerous conditions" on its property; an "affirmative duty" exists to warn of possible danger at the hands of some third party. This timely warning must include; the details and description of the time, place and suspect(s) of the incident, to the extent reported to law enforcement officials.
