### FINANCIAL AID DATA

For the Class of 2012, financial aid of \$26,100,000 was offered to 1,065 students. The aid consisted of approximately \$19,800,000 in Bucknell scholarships, \$1,100,000 in other grants, \$4,500,000 in student loans and \$700,000 in student employment.

Of the enrolled members of the Class of 2012, 497 students will receive approximately \$13,900,000 in financial aid. That aid is distributed as \$10,200,000 in Bucknell scholarships, \$900,000 in other grants, \$2,500,000 in student loans and \$300,000 in student employment.

Average Aid Package: The average financial aid award for first-year students with financial need in the fall of 2008 is about \$25,000, which includes scholarships, loans and work study.

Average loan total upon graduation: about \$19,500

Percent of undergraduates receiving some form of financial aid: 62%
