

Highlight your informative title in large font at the top *List author(s) near title in smaller font*

1. Abstract

Provide headings in large font

Label or number headings to guide the reader

Provide a synthesis of the contents of the poster here

Use size 18-21 font so your audience can read from several feet away

Be sure to double-space text to make it easier to read

2. Introduction

Introduce the sedimentary geology topic here.

This is a good place to cite a broad figure (Figure 1).

Provide large, high-quality figures to supplement text.

All figures should be necessary - avoid random, aesthetically pleasing images

Figure 1 - Provide an informative caption for each figure and the source (Hall, 2007).

3. Findings

- Subheadings might be useful here.
- Bulleted lists are an effective way to summarize key points!

4. Summary/Conclusions

- A bulleted list is an effective way to summarize key points
- This is an important section - your audience may only read this section!

5. References Cited

All references cited in your poster should be listed here

Don't list papers/books that you read but did not cite

GSA is the recommended format - see a recent article in GSA Today (available free online)
