

INFORMATION FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS REGARDING MEDICAL CARE

As a graduate student at Bucknell University, you have the option to utilize the Student Health Service (SHS) for your medical care and health education needs, **or** you may choose to continue receiving medical treatment from your family physician.

If you choose to use the Student Health Service, Bucknell's **Medical Record** must be completed in its entirety and returned to the SHS prior to registration. Parts I and II are to be completed by you and Parts III, IV and V require completion by a physician. The form and instructions are available online at www.bucknell.edu/HealthServices (Student Information) or in the offices of Graduate Studies and the Student Health Service

If you prefer to continue with your current health care provider, Bucknell requires:

- Mantoux TB Test and Results (within 1 year of matriculation)
- TDAP (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis) vaccine within the last 10 years
- Meningitis vaccine received within the past three years, or a signed waiver for the vaccine.

The form for reporting these vaccines (**Graduate/Non-Degree Students Medical Requirements for Admission form**) is available online at www.bucknell.edu/HealthServices (Student Information) or in the Graduate Studies and Student Health Service offices. This document must be completed and returned to the SHS prior to registration. It is possible to have the Mantoux TB test administered for a fee and to obtain a prescription for the meningitis vaccine (should you choose not to waive it) at our health center. Please call the SHS for details.

Failure to comply with TB/TDAP/Meningitis requirements will result in a hold on your registration.
