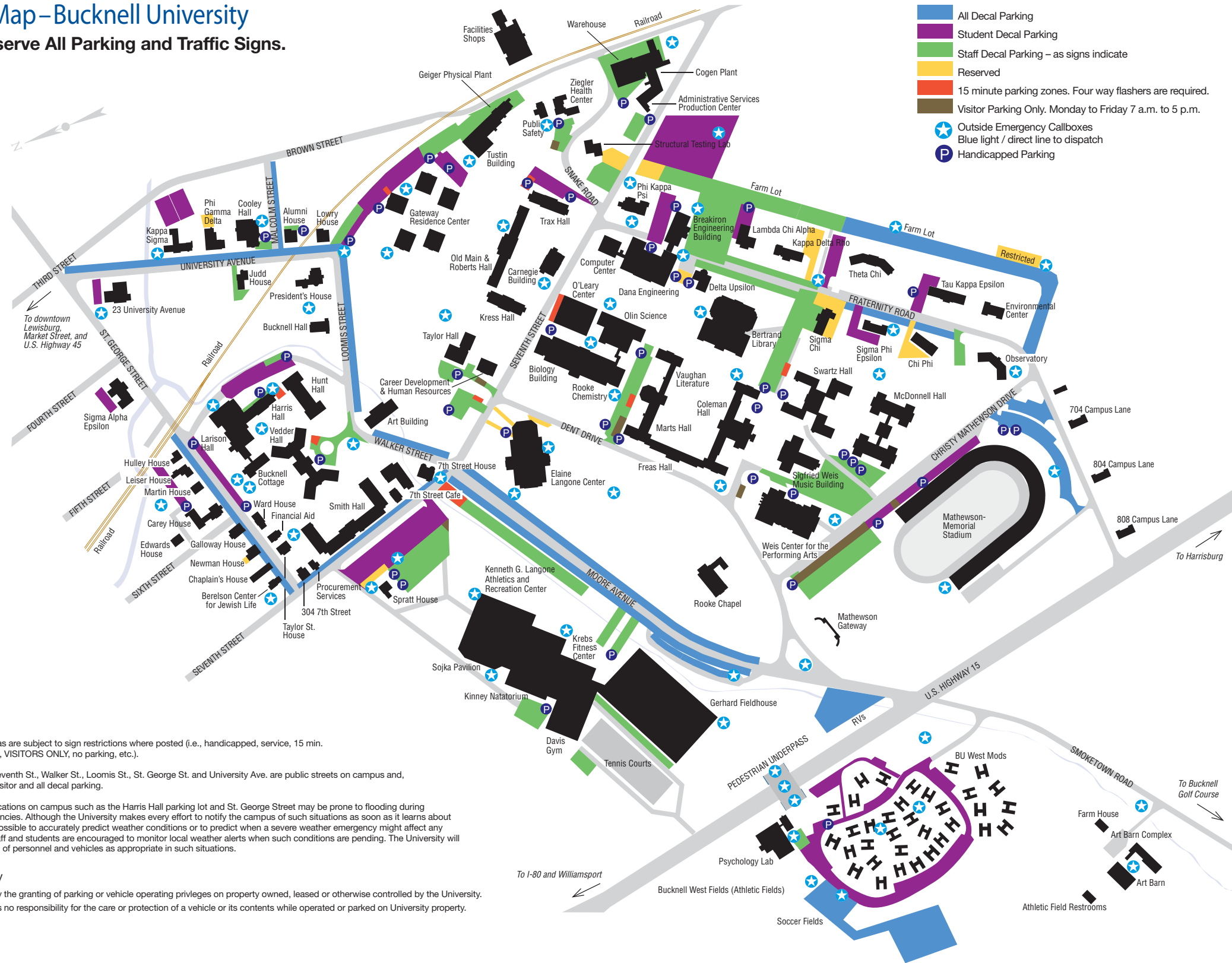


Parking Map–Bucknell University

Please Observe All Parking and Traffic Signs.



NOTE: All parking areas are subject to sign restrictions where posted (i.e., handicapped, service, 15 min. Staff only, loading zone, VISITORS ONLY, no parking, etc.).

NOTE: Moore Ave., Seventh St., Walker St., Loomis St., St. George St. and University Ave. are public streets on campus and, as such, available for visitor and all decal parking.

CAUTION: Certain locations on campus such as the Harris Hall parking lot and St. George Street may be prone to flooding during severe weather emergencies. Although the University makes every effort to notify the campus of such situations as soon as it learns about them, it is not always possible to accurately predict weather conditions or to predict when a severe weather emergency might affect any part of the campus. Staff and students are encouraged to monitor local weather alerts when such conditions are pending. The University will authorize the relocation of personnel and vehicles as appropriate in such situations.

No liability is created by the granting of parking or vehicle operating privileges on property owned, leased or otherwise controlled by the University. The University assumes no responsibility for the care or protection of a vehicle or its contents while operated or parked on University property.

SPECIFIC VIOLATIONS AND FINES

Fines for successive tickets of the following violations will increase according to a prescribed schedule:

A – \$20, 30, 35, 40, 50 **B** – \$40, 60, 65, 70, 100

1*	Operating vehicle in reckless fashion (i.e. speeding, improper operation, failure to stop at stop signs, driving on the wrong side of the road and similar violations of the Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code, borough or township ordinances)	B
2*	Failing to register vehicle	\$100
3	Possessing an illegal vehicle	B
4*	Parking in a disabled space	B
5	Parking adjacent to a fire hydrant	B
6	Failing to report change of license plate number	A
7	Obstructing driveways, roadways and delivery entrances or creating a hazard by parking in other than authorized area	B
8	Parking in a "No Parking" zone	A
9	Parking outside designated lines, all valid spaces have two lines, side to side or front and back of vehicle. Vehicle must be parked within both lines.	A
10	Overtime parking 15-minute or 30-minute zones	A
11	Student in Staff Parking	A
12	Parking on crosswalk	A
13	Double parking	A
14	Disregarding a police or public safety officer's signal or verbal command	B
15	Driving with excessive vehicle noise	A
16	Driving or parking on grass or landscaping	B
17	Display of decal improperly	A
18	Failure to display decal	A
19	Parking within 20 feet of corner/driveway	A
20	Failure to yield to pedestrian(s)	A
21	Driving around or removing a blockade	B
22	Driving or parking on paths or sidewalks	B
23	Overloading and riding on back of cars	B
24	Backing into a parking space/pulling through	A
25	Hazard lights violation	A
26	Parking against the flow of traffic	A
27*	Parking in a loading or fire zone	B
28	Parking in service vehicle area	A
29	Parking in a visitor space	A
30	Parking in an unauthorized space	A
31*	Illegal transfer of parking permit or information	B
32*	Providing false parking or registration information	B
33	License verification fee	A
34	Employee in student parking	A
35	Possessing or operating a vehicle by an ineligible person	\$50
36	Vehicle immobilization (wheel boot) fee	\$75 fifth ticket
37*	Tampering with or removal of an immobilization device (wheel boot)	\$75 fifth ticket

Violations not able to be appealed are: 2, 4, 11, 34 and 37.

Disciplinary actions imposed by the Department of Public Safety as a result of parking violations are not able to be appealed.
