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To obtain ESL Program Specialist certification students must:

- o Complete the required courses listed below
- o Provide evidence of at least 60 hours of field experiences (to be completed in EDUC 375)
- o Submit a portfolio documenting acquisition of required competencies for review by the end of the semester enrolled in EDUC 375

Having completed the courses and field experiences required for the ESL Program Specialist certification, candidates with existing instructional certificates can apply for their additional certification as an ESL Program Specialist K-12. The ESL Program Specialist is an endorsement to an existing PA teaching certificate. It cannot stand alone. Other states will probably have additional requirements for ESL certification.

The following courses are required to complete the ESL Program Specialist certification. Course substitutions are rarely made.
