Lawrence C. Reardon is professor of political science at the University of New Hampshire (B.A., Johns Hopkins 1979; Ph.D. Columbia 1991). His books include The Reluctant Dragon (University of Washington, 2002), A Third Way (Harvard, 2020) and co-edited The Vatican, and the Nation-State (Georgetown, 2006). He has published in China Quarterly, China Law and Government, Journal of Contemporary China, China Business Review, The Journal of Shenzhen University. The Journal of Current Chinese Affairs, The Oxford Encyclopedia of Politics and Religion, and The Cambridge History of Nationhood and Nationalism. Currently, he is co-editing China and Integrated Deterrence (Cambria Press) and writing a chapter on China's Belt and Road for The Great Power Competition (Springer).
