LODGING IN UNIVERSITY RESIDENCE HALLS

Room Information:

- Rooms are available for Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights, May 15, 16 and 17, on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Lodging Rates:
 Single Room \$55 per night
 Double Room \$80 per night
 (Note: single room = 1 single bed; double room = 2 single beds)
 - A 6% hotel occupancy tax is required on all rooms.
- Room reservations are nonrefundable.
- Linens, a summer-weight blanket, pillow and towel are provided. There is no towel or linen exchange.
- Graduates will remain in their residence hall rooms.
- Make reservations by Friday, May 8, online at bucknell.edu/commencement.
- If you or your guests have a special medical condition or disability and desire accessible accommodations, please provide a brief description of needs on the online form. A limited number of accessible rooms are available and will be assigned based on availability.
- A limited number of rooms with private bathrooms are available only for individuals with disabilities.
- Any guest under 18 must be accompanied by an adult 21 years or older.
- Pick up keys for reserved rooms during the following dates/times on the second floor of the Elaine Langone Center:

Commencement Ceremony

- Tickets are not required for Commencement if held outside on Malesardi Ouad.
- No rehearsal for graduating students is scheduled for the Commencement Ceremony; information will be sent to graduating students from the Office of the Registrar before the end of the semester.
- General information about the Commencement Ceremony (special seating, first-aid station, etc.) will be available at kiosks on Malesardi Quad prior to and during the Ceremony.
- At least one guest must remain to hold seats on Malesardi Quad. Items left unattended will be removed and can be claimed in the Office of the Registrar, 102 Marts Hall, following the Ceremony.
- Lost-and-found items will be held at the Switchboard on the second floor in the Elaine Langone Center.
- Restrooms are available on all floors of Bertrand Library, Coleman Hall, the Vaughan Literature Building and the Elaine Langone Center. Portable restroom facilities will be available on the east and west sides of the Library. All facilities are accessible, with the exception of the portable restrooms.
- The outside Ceremony is held on the lawn. Please dress appropriately for grass and weather.
- Beverage stations will be located near the Library on the south end of Malesardi Quad.
- A live webcast of the Commencement Ceremony will be available. For information and a link to the live webcast, visit bucknell.edu/CommencementLive.

Accessible Seating: Wheelchairs and Deaf or Hard of Hearing

- Seating arrangements are available on a limited basis for individuals using a wheelchair or who are Deaf or Hard of Hearing. Each guest in this area may be accompanied by one additional guest.
- Call the Commencement hotline at 570-577-1192 before Friday, May 8, to make arrangements for this seating area or for details pertaining to local durable medical equipment vendors. The University does not loan or rent wheelchairs.
- Guests should be advised that the outdoor Ceremony is held in an unshaded area.
- An alternative indoor viewing area will be available in Trout Auditorium in the Vaughan Literature Building.

Inclement Weather

- In case of rain, the Ceremony may be held in Gerhard Fieldhouse or delayed up to two hours, then remain outdoors as planned.
- Graduating students will receive five tickets each for the indoor Ceremony when they pick up their caps & gowns.
- Guests who do not have tickets may view the Ceremony by live webcast in the Weis Center for the Performing Arts and Trout Auditorium in the Vaughan Literature Building.
- If the Ceremony is delayed or moved to the indoor location, an announcement will be sent through campus email notification. You may also call 570-577-2000 for updates. Signs will be posted at the entrances to Malesardi Quadrangle and the lobby of the Elaine Langone Center.
