## Financial Aid & Scholarships for Off-campus Study

### Bucknell Aid/Loans:

Students who are currently eligible for financial aid, will continue to maintain their aid package while studying off-campus through "Bucknell approved provider" programs or "Bucknell in" programs. However, students who are currently participating in work study will not be eligible to participate in this program while studying off-campus.
