

Flight Ticket Reimbursement Policy for Bucknell in Programs including

Bucknell in Athens, Bucknell en España, Bucknell en France, Bucknell in Ghana, Bucknell in London

The amount of flight ticket reimbursement is determined by the cost per ticket of the “Bucknell in” group flight.

If a student elects not to participate in their “Bucknell in” program’s group flight please note the following:

- The amount of reimbursement paid will be no more than the amount paid for the group flight, even if the amount paid exceeds the group flight fare.
- Likewise, students will be reimbursed only the face value of their ticket even if the fare paid is less than the group flight fare.
- Reimbursement will not be given for tickets purchased with frequent flyer miles or other means that do not show a cash value.

An original, valid receipt must be submitted for reimbursement. Please note that reimbursement will be credited to the student’s [BBill](#) account **after** they have arrived in their host country.

The deadline for Reimbursement Requests for the fall semester is **October 15.**

The deadline for Reimbursement Requests for the spring semester is **March 1.**

GROUP FLIGHT CHANGE NOTE: It is not uncommon for airlines to need to delay and/or even reschedule flights. If the program-purchased group flight is rescheduled by the airline for a later time or date, students are expected to abide by the flight change. However, if a student chooses to book a different flight or a flight on another airline, no reimbursement will be given for the new ticket purchased and/or the fees incurred. If due diligence has been shown by the program, Anthony Travel, and the airline to re-book flights with no fees incurred, new tickets purchased independently by students and any fees incurred for their purchase must be paid by the student; no reimbursement will be given from the program.

The student hereby acknowledges that if they freely and willingly chose to make individual travel arrangements or alternative travel arrangements, before or after the program start/end dates, the student will be responsible for all costs associated with these alternative arrangements.
