
Camp Duffy and Camp Scout Cabin University Guidelines

The cabins, Camp Duffy and Camp Scout, were constructed for those that are pure nature enthusiasts. Each cabin includes a table, a set of bunks, a loft, fire pit, and outside grill. Cabins sleep a maximum of 7 adults. There is no running water or electricity, and cell service is limited.

Please read the information below and agree to the terms and conditions at the end.

Check-in

- The cabin(s) will be unlocked for your arrival, and the Caretaker will greet you, at some point, upon your arrival.
- A packet of local information and a tote of necessities will be available to you and can be found in the cabin.
 - A key to lock the cabin will be available upon request prior to check-in.

Parking

- Park in the parking lot located at the high elements course, located on the right when you first enter the property. The cabins will be a short walk down the road on the left.
- Do not drive on the lawn to the cabins, but you may temporarily park on the road close by the lawn to the cabins to unload.
- Do not park on the lawn.

Restrooms

- Restrooms are located near the high elements course, where you've parked.
- Restrooms will be unlocked during your stay.
- There are no showers or running water in the restrooms.

Barbecue and Fire Pit

- Each cabin has their own barbecue, fire pit, and wood supply.
- Dry wood for campfires can be found by a nearby storage shed.

- Please return all unused wood to the storage shed.

Garbage and Recycling

- Take garbage/recyclables to the dumpster by the Conference Center.
- Completely clean out the fire pit and surrounding area when done by using equipment provided.

Check Out

- Check out is at **11 a.m.**
- Please leave your key inside the cabin on the table.
- If you're interested in leaving feedback on your stay, please fill out our feedback form which can be found on the table.

Suggested Items to Bring

- Bedding/mattress/pads
- Charcoal and lighter fluid
- Food and cooking utensils/supplies
- Matches
- Water
- Chairs
- Flashlights/lanterns
- Food

Groups are responsible for adhering to the following rules/regulations:

- Walk only on the paths and respect the natural habitat of the wildlife
- Fishing permitted with a current PA license
- No hunting
- No alcohol
- No open flames inside the cabins
- No vandalism
- No pets (of any kind) are permitted on the grounds with the exception of service animals
- Respect quiet times beginning at 10 p.m. on weekdays and 11 p.m. on weekends
- No smoking inside the cabins
